MISS MEMORIAL DAY PAGEANT RULES & REGULATIONS FOR CONTESTANTS

Contestant must be the age of her category by the FIRST DAY OF APRIL in the YEAR of the pageant.

1. Contestant must certify that she is not now and never has been married, has never had a marriage annulled and has never given birth to a child.
2. Contestant must be a legal resident of the U.S. and certifies that she lives or attends school in Georgia.
3. Contestant must be in good health and of good moral character. She can not have been paneled, have over 10 absences, have a misdemeanor or a felony charge, arrest, or conviction. She must possess intelligence, charm, & believe in the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America.
4. Application and fee must be submitted or be postmarked by **April 14th**. If you miss the deadline, you **MUST CALL** PAGEANT DIRECTOR (770 826-8704) and deliver your entry to her home. Crowns & sashes are ordered on April 15. We must have a contestant count. Email questions to Cynthia_sold_it@yahoo.com

I understand that if I am the MISS (17-23 yrs old) winner of the MMD pageant, I will participate in the events that the director has arranged for me which includes 7 days of specific appearances including; the Dacula Memorial Day Parade/Festival & GOVERNMENT DAY. I understand that if I am crowned Miss Memorial Day, I will ONLY receive my scholarship AFTER I have met all my appearance requirements. I will receive my cash Scholarship the night I give up my crown. I forfeit the scholarship if I do not attend & participate in the seven events scheduled for Miss Memorial Day. Additional events may include pageant hostessing, pageant judging, service project days & other work days. I also understand if I miss events, I must meet with my director so the 1st runner up will be accorded the title of Miss Memorial Day due to my breaking the requirements of the title Miss Memorial Day.

I agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the local and state organization now in effect or as announced hereafter from time to time.

I further acknowledge that I am in good health and will be able to participate in all areas of competition without assistance in the usually accepted manner.

I agree that the time, manner and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the Miss Memorial Day Pageant and that any decision of the judges or the director will be final.

I further permit my photography, likeness, voice recording and name to be used without charge for all publicity and commercial purposes and I understand I may appear on internet websites or television.

I agree that if I become the winner of this pageant, that for my year as reigning queen, I will not give any written or oral endorsement of any mercantile commodity or commercial or charitable organization, nor will I make any MMD appearances, without written authorization from my pageant director.

I acknowledge ownership by Miss Memorial Day Pageant and the validity of the name, Miss GEORGIA, Queen of Memorial Day, Miss Memorial Day and all Miss Memorial Day Pageant titles, and that I will not jeopardize such property rights in any manner whatsoever.

Failure of the winning contestant to comply with any of the terms, restrictions, provisions or obligations hereof, shall, at the sole opinion of the Miss Memorial Day Pageant, result in contestant's disqualification, loss of title and return of any and all prizes awarded, including the winning trophy, crown and sash.

I understand that if I am selected as the winner of the Miss Memorial Day Pageant, I can win other titles but will attend all required events throughout the year as a Miss Memorial Day Queen.

I will not hold the pageant, its owners or workers responsible for any loss or damage to personal property or person during the pageant, parade day or during my reign.

Pageant Royalty Titles

MISS INDEPENDENCE - Interview Winner

The Interview/Introduction winner is the top scorer which best presents herself in the interview or introduction portion of the pageant and will win this sash & title. Her voice, presence, composure, answers, & speaking ability will be judged. Only our MISS & TEEN contestants will have a scheduled 4-minute interview with the judges on pageant day. All introduction scores will also be considered for this title. Questions are from entry form.

MISS AMERICAN QUEEN – Top Pageant Project Fund Raiser

Miss American Queen is awarded to one contestant, in both pageants, that collects the highest total dollar amount through pre-pageant fund raising. This money will go towards our 2012 Service Project, “YOUR VOTE COUNTS!” that register new voters for the 2012 election year. The money will also be used to honor the military during the Dacula Memorial Day parade by buying supplies for our Queens Float. Sponsorship money may be collected from family, businesses, & friends. Sponsorship money must be in an envelope with contestants name & age category & given to the attendant at the pageant check-in table at check in time. This is an optional category. The winner will receive a 3 - 5 inch crown & sash. YOU MUST CALL the director, with your total amount, the night before the pageant if you will be working towards this title. You must enter this to be considered for OVER ALL TITLE OF Miss Patriotism.

MISS AMERICAN SWEETHEART – Audience Favorite

Our Miss American Sweetheart are the two contestant that are chosen, by our audience, as their favorite contestant in each of the two pageants. Please consider personality & stage presence. Cash vote for your favorite contestant by visiting the back table with all the contestants’ photos. The girl with the highest number of votes will be awarded the title of Miss American Sweetheart & designer sash, one in the YOUTH and one in the MISS Pageant. You must enter this title to be considered for OVERALL Miss Patriotism title.

MISS SPIRIT OF AMERICA – Leadership, Community Service, Volunteer

To enter to win this title you must fill out The Miss Spirit of America separate form and mail in with your pageant entry form. The Miss Spirit of America title is given to the young lady scoring highest on leadership, community service, & volunteer portion of the pageant. In the younger age groups please list activities that your daughter is involved in with your family. Our Miss Spirit of America will be awarded the Joseph R. and Virginia B. Littleton Volunteer of the Year Award plaque. You must enter this to be considered for over all Miss Patriotism title.

MISS LIBERTY - Red, White and Blue Fashion Show Winner

Miss Liberty is the contestant scoring highest in Red, White & BLUE opening number. ALL contestants will select an all American Red, White & Blue outfit to model on the runway. Props are acceptable. Outfits can run from casual to dressy as long as it is patriotic in nature. No formal gowns or animals. Judging will be scored 50% Style & Design of outfit & 50% Modeling Capability (i.e. Self Introduction, presence on stage, physical fitness, modeling style, command of the audience, feel good aura about contestant and clean look. IN ADDITION those aged 9 & older will introduce themselves DURING THE OPENING NUMBER. The introduction, 30 seconds or less, will include your name, age, city, school and what you like best about living in America or your city. Winner will receive a Title Sash and will carry the Dacula Memorial Day Parade Banner.

MISS ARMED FORCES - Contestant With An Active Serving Military Family Member

This title is given to a contestant whom has a family member serving in the military. You must bring a index card with the following information about your serving family member for the MC to read during this portion of the pageant. Please include their; name, rank, branch of service, where they are stations and years of service.

MISS AMERICAN BEAUTY - Portfolio Winner

This is an OPTIONAL TITLE that is open to all contestants. It is an additional \$25 to enter our Miss American Beauty. Your portfolio should have between 6-15 photos with head shots, & 3/4 shots. Judging is photogenic quality, quality of photography &, variety of work. Use slim Portfolios over fat heavy albums. Judging is BEFORE the pageant so it must be turned in 1 hour before to Director. You must enter this to be considered for OVER ALL Miss Patriotism title.

MISS PATRIOTISM - Supreme Pageant Supporter

This title given to only one contestant that has entered the four following Royalty Titles; Miss American Beauty, Miss Spirit of America, Miss American Sweetheart, & Miss American Queen. Scores from each of these titles will be tallied & the one contestant with the highest score will be win the OVER ALL title of Miss Patriotism. She will be on the Queens Court. You do not have to win the Queen Age Division to be Miss Patriotism. We encourage all contestants to compete for each of the above titles for the full pageant experience. MISS MEMORIAL DAY PRINCESS - Each contestant that shows grace with pageant manners will be crowned a Miss Memorial Day Princesses & receive her crown & sash. They are to be worn during the Dacula Memorial Day Parade/Festival & other requested appearances dates.
